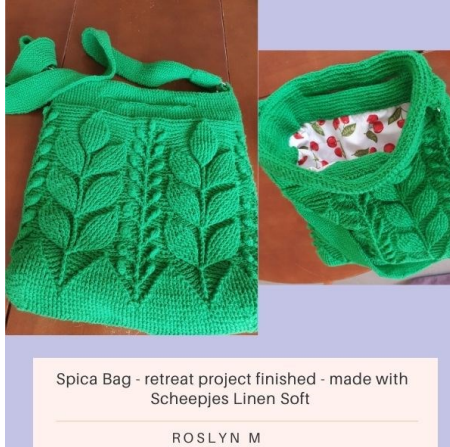


# Customers' Corner

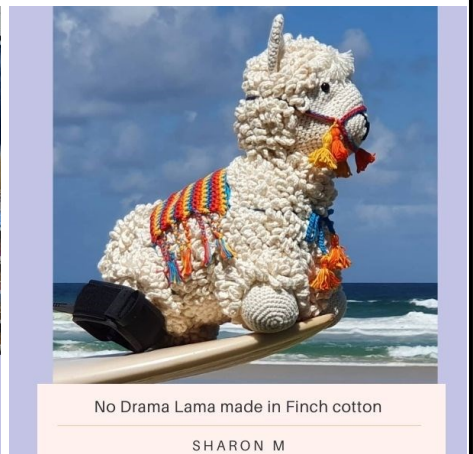

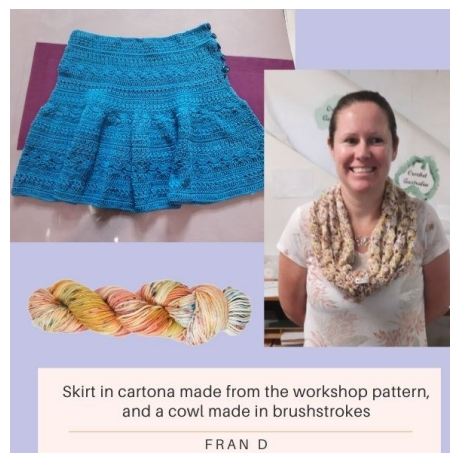

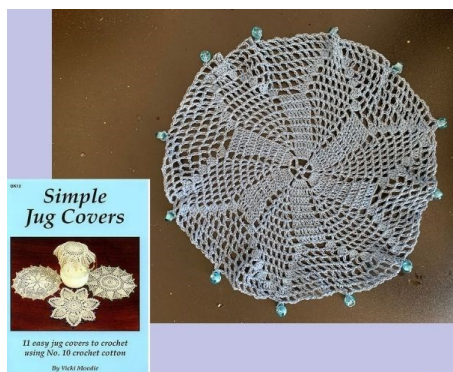
